Technical information for use of BlueUp Ultra in professional healthcare environments

Introduction

This Annex is an integral part of the user manual of BlueUp Ultra (henceforth identified with the terms "product", "device" or "beacon") for installation and use in professional healthcare facility environment.

Precautions

WARNING: Use of this equipment adjacent to or stacked with other equipment should be avoided because it could result in improper operation. If such use is necessary, this equipment and the other equipment should be observed to verify that they are operating normally.

WARNING: Portable RF communications equipment (including peripherals such as antenna cables and external antennas) should be used no closer than 30 cm (12 inches) to any part of BlueUp Ultra, including cables specified by the manufacturer. Otherwise, degradation of the performance of this equipment could result.
